



How to apply for a scholarship

Welcome to this instruction page on how to apply for a scholarship. Applying for a scholarship requires you to take a few simple steps. Before starting your application, please make sure that you have all the necessary application documents at hand.

- 1. First, navigate to the Admissions Portal in Osiris.
- 2. Log in with your student account if you are not logged in yet.
- 3. Once you log in, you will see the application form titled 'Application Scholarship Research Master Erasmus MC 2025' in the Admissions Portal.
- 4. In order to fill out the application form, click on "view/edit"
