Theoretical Analytic Philosophy

This course provides an introduction into the methods and foundations of theoretical analytic philosophy. More in particular, we start with concise introduction to:

1. *Methodology of analytic philosophy.* You will learn how to apply the core concepts and methods of analytic philosophy.

After that, you are introduced to the three foundational disciplines of *theoretical* analytic philosophy:

- 2. Logic. You will learn how to use the tools of symbolic logic to asses the (in)validity of arguments.
- 3. *Epistemology*. You will learn how to evaluate core arguments and views about knowledge, justified belief and their social dimension.
- **4.** *Metaphysics.* You will learn how to apply core arguments and views about the structure of reality.

The course enables you to reflect on the nature of analytic philosophy as a discipline and its import in addressing issues of societal relevance.
