# Spanish A2.1 Pre-intermediate 1

#### What will you learn?

A Spanish A2.1 course consists of ten weekly sessions of 2,5 hours each. This course is a continuation of the course Spanish A1. During this course you will continue with the previously learned topics of the Spanish language, with emphasis on reading, speaking, listening and writing skills in an everyday context. Topics that are covered include:

- daily activities;
- food and drinks;
- grocery shopping, ordering in a bar or restaurant;
- studies and work;
- making an appointment;
- travelling and hotels;
- grammar and vocabulary;
- culture and habits in Spanish speaking countries.

By the end of the course, you will have a small vocabulary to be able to communicate orally and in writing about personal topics and in common and everyday situations. The final level of the course is A2.1 according to the Common European Framework of Reference (<u>CEFR</u>).

# Admission requirements

Please note: You have to do an <u>intake</u> BEFORE you register for the course. To be admitted to this course, your current

level of the language needs to be at Spanish A1.

As proof of this entrance level we accept the following:

- Spanish 2.1 advice of an LTC's assessment (less than 12 months old);
- the LTC certificate of Spanish A1 course (less than 12 months old);
- If you are currently participating in the Spanish A1 course of the LTC, you are allowed to register for this Spanish A2.1 course. Passing for your final exam and thus completing the course with a Pass is necessary to start the following level.

#### Good to know

- This course is available for participants with an academic background (hbo/university).
- Course participants are expected to spend approximately three hours a week on course preparation and self-study.

- A final written exam is part of this course. Dyslectic students can get extra time to complete the written test. To arrange this, you need to contact the LTC via <u>email</u>. You will also have to send a copy of your official statement of special needs.
- A certificate is awarded to participants who achieve a total score of 5.5 or higher.

#### **Course material**

The course material costs approximately € 35,- and is not included in the course fee. You will receive a confirmation letter with further details when the course starts.
