

Critical World Citizenship Skills



Calm perseverance; ability to identify when to sit back and listen, when to speak up; long-term thinking; underpins all skills



Evaluate reliability, credibility of information (types) to contextualise knowledge and its production



Gathering perspectives; facilitating personal connection; hearing all voices




Learning from (own) mistakes and success; attention for (self-)analysis of actions, feelings and thoughts; focused on DOING



Openness to different value systems – curiosity, respect and humility – willingness to embrace/learn from cultural diversity




Intellectually: recognizing frames of reference and ability to shift between them; Inter-personally: connection, emotional attunement (what do they hear/see/say/do?)



Reflection on one's relations to knowledge (production); situatedness of experiences and perspectives; focused on BEING



Liberty to act or decide independently; requires courage aimed at (self-) empowerment; carries responsibility towards others and their rights



Becoming a critical world citizen is a constant challenge; an urge to learn from mistakes while making fun together
