You have requested to take your exam via online proctoring. This means the following:

- **15 minutes before the exam starts** you log in to ANS (<https://ans.app/>) using Google Chrome.
- You select the exam in the list of 'Scheduled assignments' (please note in case the exam has already started, you can find the exam in the list of 'Live assignments')
- Click the button 'Launch ProctorExam' (scroll down for the button)
- Follow the instructions for setting up ProctorExam
- Once you have done this, please click on the link in ProctorExam to go back to ANS
- You are now ready to start with exam

* The ProctorExam system check is not a required action. You will start ProctorExam via ANS. **You are urgently advised to check your own systems well before the exam date.** Please visit:
