## EDITORIAL

Dear Friends of POTEnT,

As 2021 comes to a close, so does another year of POTEnT cooperation.

This year has been an important one for our project: despite the impossibility to meet in person, our partners exchanged best practices and projects through a huge number of online study visits, involving around a hundred of people in the knowledge exchange. An incredible result despite the limitations we still live.

It's been a challenging 12 months, but the best is yet to come: the next months will be the most important ones in our journey towards a locally driven energy transition. While our cities have already in place some of the energy solutions they need, many more will be brought to scale thanks to POTEnT cooperation and good practice exchange. Our partners' Regional Action Plans containing ambitious policy improvements will be ready in Spring 2022 and after that each one will start with the implementation phase, that we will follow with a 12-months close monitoring period.

In this edition, we also share highlights from some of our partners: Parma gained an important recognition for its efforts on climate neutrality, ALOEN presents an inspiring programme for energy renovation and real estate transactions, while Ostrava is making big steps towards the SECAP.

Incredible momentum is growing for our partners, and our goal is to make 2022 a very special year for all POTEnT partners!
