- Level B2 (CEFR) for students of
Erasmus+ partner universities



Language requirements

Every incoming exchange student needs to prove their English proficiency. You can take one of these four tests to demonstrate your English language proficiency. The following scores are required:

- 100 TOEFL (iBT - min. scores of at least 20 on all components)
- 7.0 IELTS overall (at least a score of 6.0 on all components)
- Minimum C2 Proficiency with a minimum overall score of 185
- Minimum C1 Advanced with a minimum overall score of 185

Students whose native language is English or whose study programme at the home university is completely taught in English, do not need to take an English proficiency test.

Application procedure

After nomination by the home university, students are invited to complete our online application form with the following required documents:

- Official Transcript of Records (starting from Bachelor year 1 to present, including courses you are currently enrolled in). All students should have completed at least one year of their Bachelor's degree programme
- Proof of English proficiency
- Motivation letter
