



## Definitions Legenda Teaching week (Dutch: 'onderwijsweek'); week with scheduled curricular education activities including lectures, tutorials, seminars and mandatory thesis supervision. Weeks in which only exams and/or resits and/or an exam training are planned are not counted as teaching weeks. Weeks that provide a combination of exams and/or resits and scheduled mandatory curricular education activities count as teaching weeks. Teaching-free week (Dutch: 'onderwijsvrije week'): week with no scheduled curricular education activities including lectures, tutorials, seminars, exams and resits. Activities that may take place in a teaching-free week concern extra-curricular activities, self-study, coaching/guidance/mentoring, check-ins, consultation moments for exams, group work including deadlines (e.g., for papers/assignments). Assessment week/resit week: Week in which only exams and/or resits and/or exam training(s) are planned. In case scheduled curricular education activities are also planned in the same week, the week is counted as a teaching week.[1] [1] Exceptions: in cases when the exam board grants additional assessment opportunities (for individual students) the exams may be scheduled in a recess or a teaching-free week. Recess Recess: a period with no scheduled curricular activities, no extra-curricular activities organised by the schools such as honours class meetings, no exams, resits or deadlines. Private time of staff and students is respected and in principle communication between students and staff (e.g., supervision, questions, announcements) is restricted.
