From Book to MOOC

In response to a request from the Executive Board, ESE has proposed to make a Massive Online Open Course (MOOC) on Econometrics. The book Econometric Methods with Applications in Business and Economics (by Christiaan Heij, Paul de Boer, Philip Hans Franses, Teun Kloek and Herman van Dijk), which is used in the courses Econometrics 1 and 2, will be the basis of inspiration for the MOOC. The Executive Board has approved this proposal, and will subsidize its realization. Our department has created a project team, consisting of Christiaan Heij, Philip Hans Franses, Dick van Dijk, Dennis Fok, Erik Kole, Richard Paap, and Michel van der Wel.

The objectives of the MOOC are threefold. In the first place it should strengthen our international reputation as one of the leading institutes in the field. Second, it should be beneficial to attract new (international) students to our programmes. Third, we can obtain experience with new developments in the online market for education. The MOOC is not meant as a substitution for or addition to the courses in our bachelor programmes. We see potential premaster students, including graduates from bachelor programmes in Economics and Business or in Engineering, as the main target audience for the MOOC. We assume they have basic knowledge of statistics and linear algebra.

RISBO and EFB will offer technical assistance for the production of the MOOC. It will be offered on the Coursera platform.

Rommert Dekker, Flavius Frasincar, Michel van de Velden and Dennis Fok are active in the new founded "Erasmus Center for Data Science and Business Analytics". The center helps companies to extract business value from their data. 
